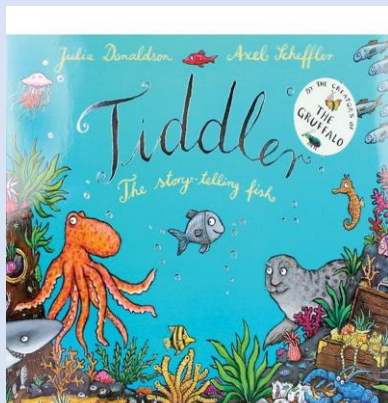

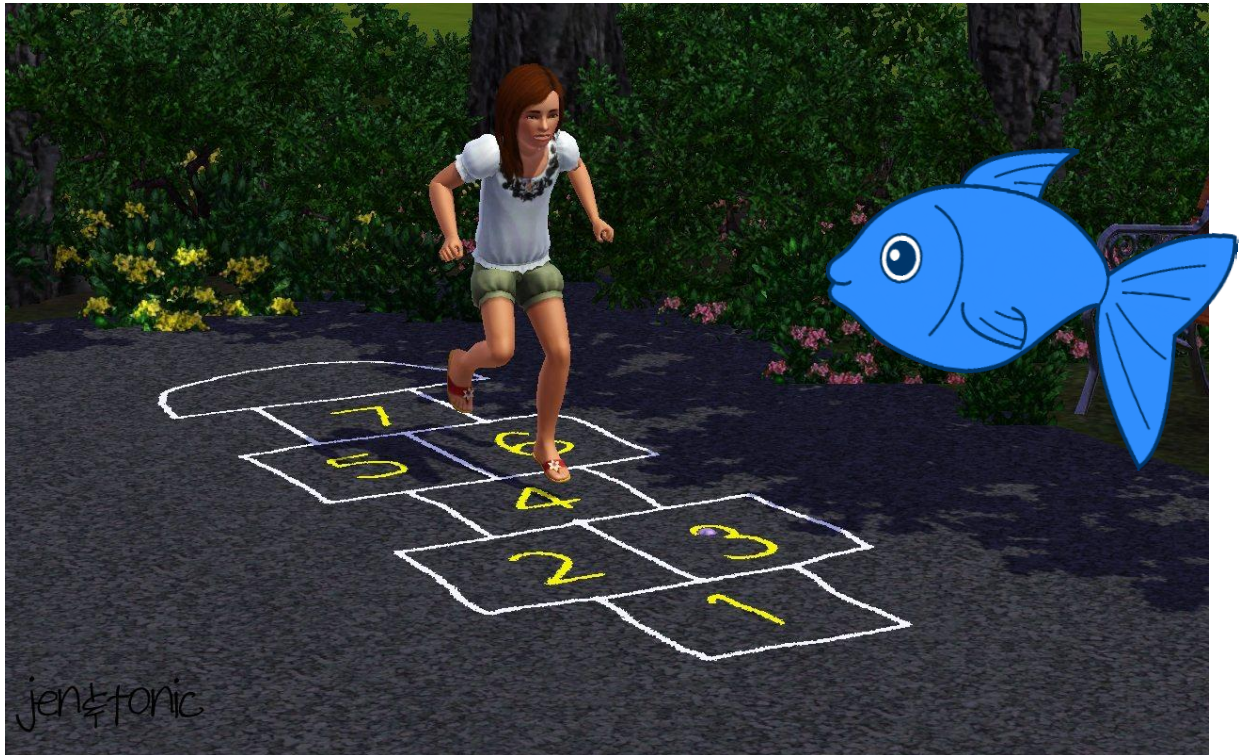




## Maths

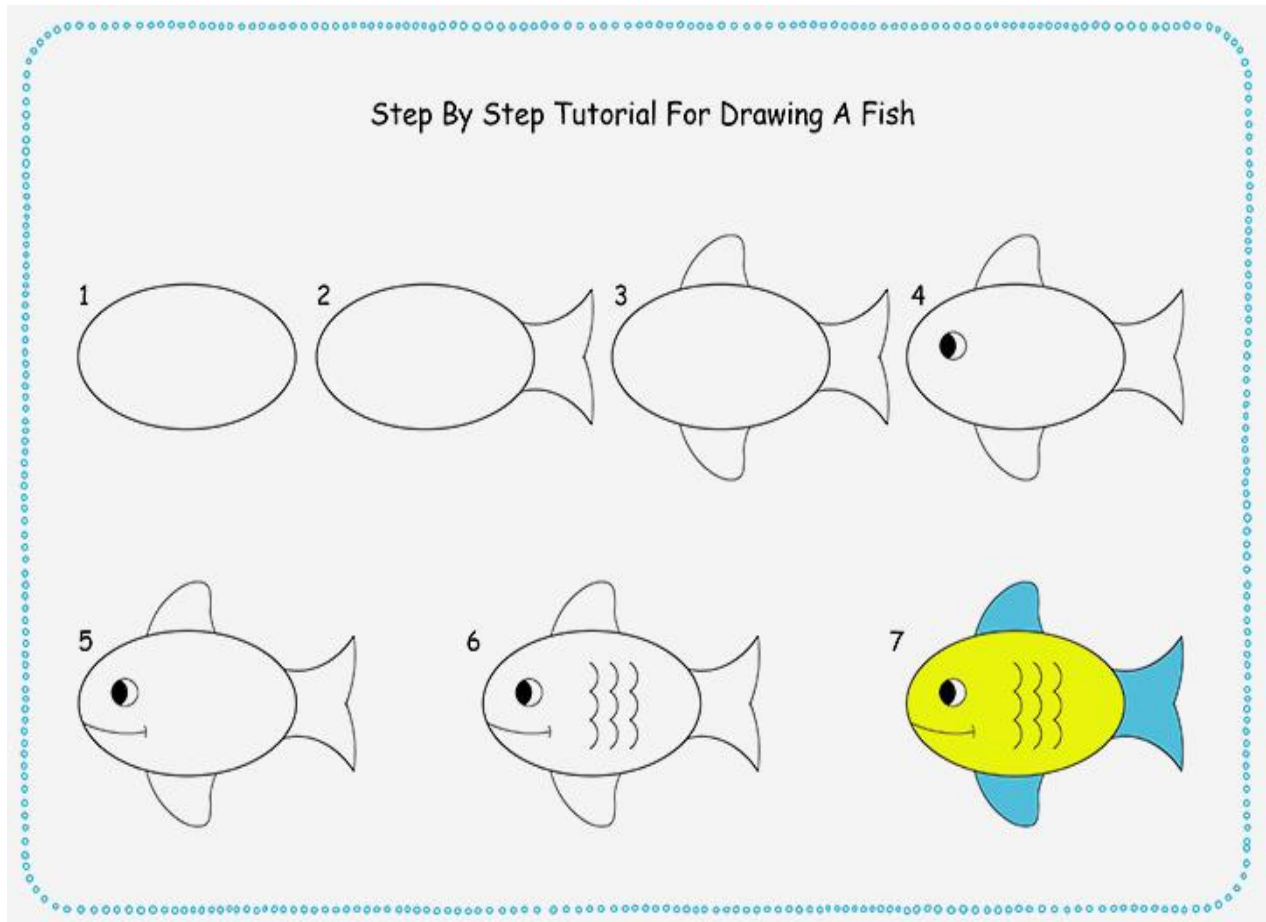


Let's have more fun with

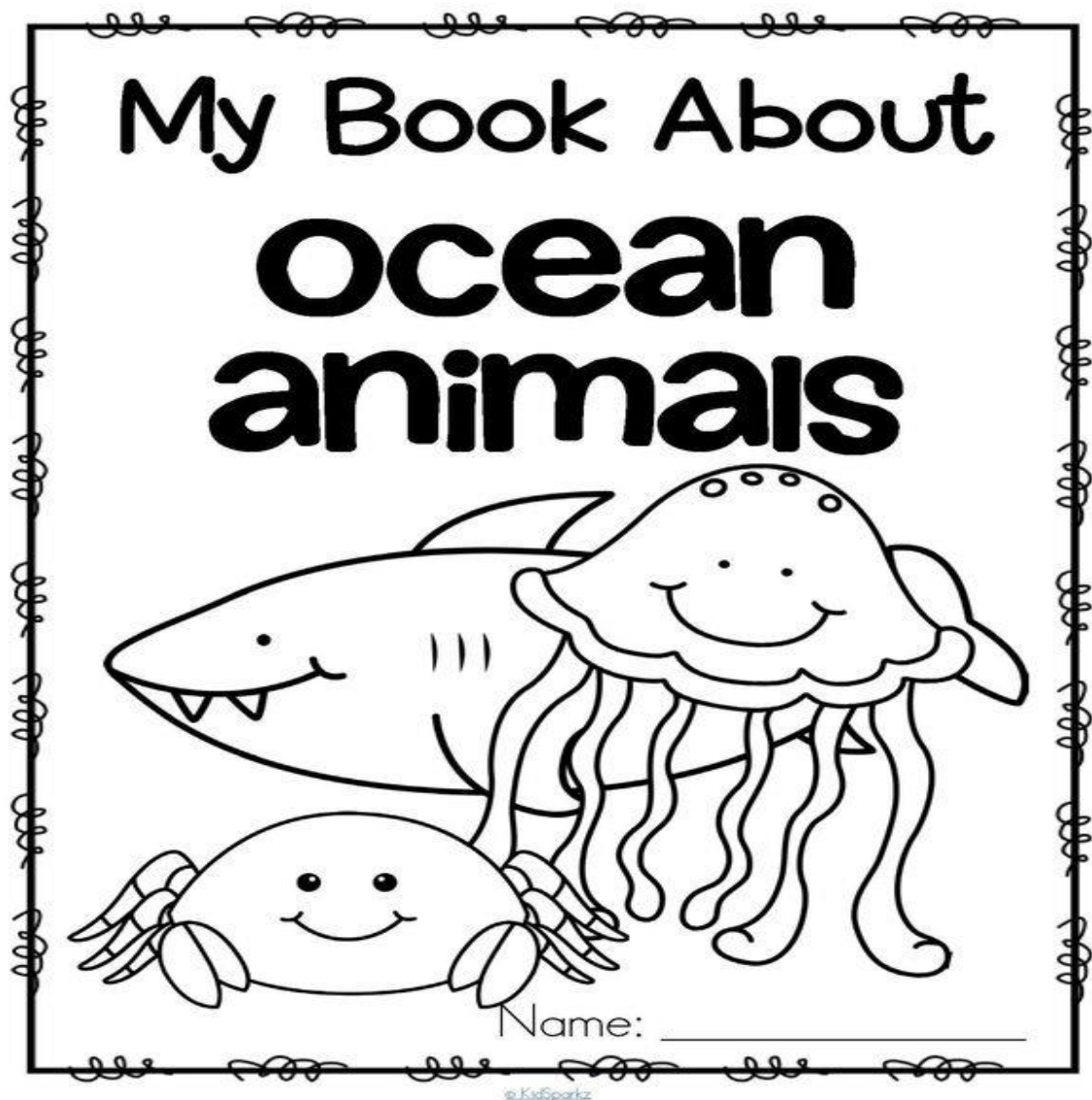


**Don't forget to keep your pictures so you can bring them into school to show Mrs Golden and Mrs Nunn.**

Learning about under the sea and sea creatures is such fun. What is your favourite sea creature and write a sentence telling us why.

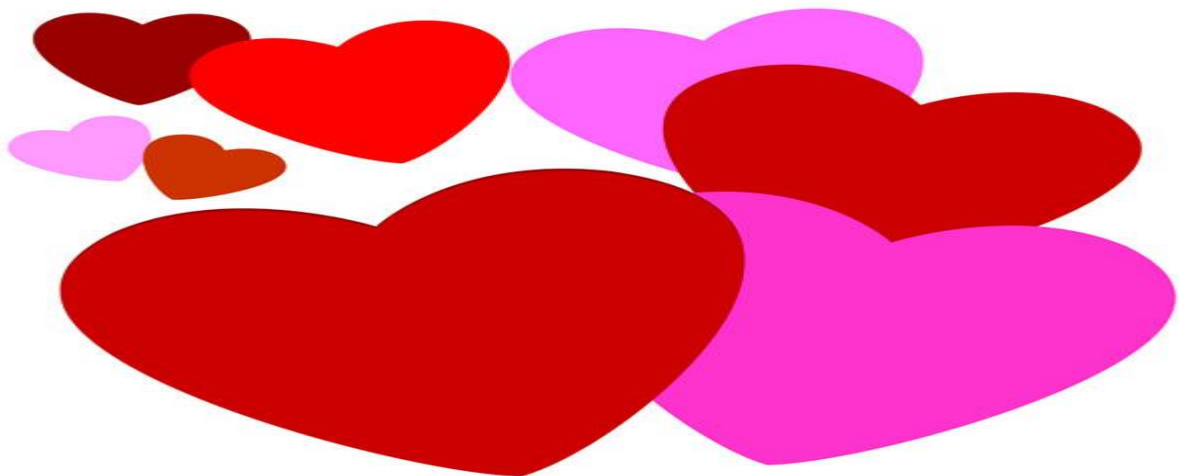
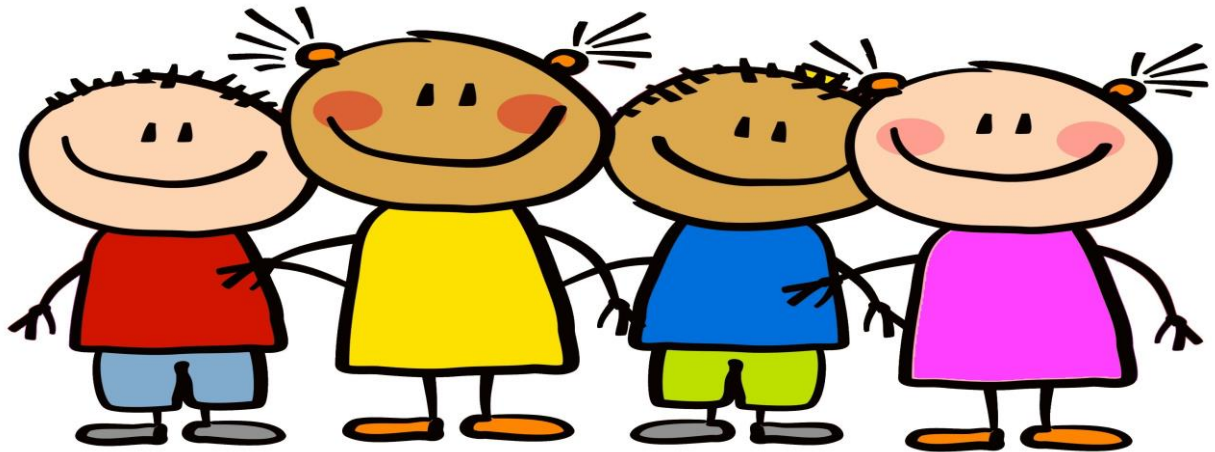
We would like you to make a book about the sea creatures you have learnt about and which stories you have read. This book can be just a few pages with pictures and some words that you have independently tried to Fred talk.
