Welcome back to the new term and what a positive feel there is to the school as we begin Term 4.

We had all been hoping that we would be able to return in full very soon and the recent news that everyone will return to school on March 8th brought great joy to us all. Further the suggestions that life might be able to go back to something like the old normal by late June is very encouraging. What is normal these days? The arrival of the Spring like weather has also helped our positive mood and outlook: it feels literally like the light at the end of the tunnel that was discussed on Monday! Nevertheless, it makes sense to move forward with great care and open up gradually. It's important to remember that, for the time being at least, all restrictions need to remain in place to control the virus and save lives.

We are still considering the prospect of running a breakfast and after school club despite the initial lack of interest because in the new situation parental circumstances may change. If we do provide these facilities the aim will be to start in September. I will write once again in the coming months to gauge interest. When the children return on the 8th March, Mrs Thompson will continue to shield at home until the end of term. She will still be involved with the class by teaching some lessons over 'Teams' on the interactive board. Miss B will be leading the class on Mondays and Tuesdays with Mrs Humphries leading it for the rest of the week.

Due to the return and staff cover, the timetables will change slightly which means PE will be on the following days for each class -

- Rabbits Tuesday
- Squirrels Thursday & Friday
- Foxes Monday & Wednesday
- Badgers Thursday & Friday
- Owls Monday & Thursday

On these days children will be expected to wear PE kit for the whole day. The PE kit expected to be worn is:

- Blue or Black shorts, joggers or leggings
- Royal Blue Jumper or Fleece with school logo.
- Royal Blue T-shirt or polo with school logo
- Plimsolls, pumps or trainers (No trainers for Rabbits class please)

I wish all of you a wonderful weekend. Please remember that despite the great news on Monday about the future, we are still in a pandemic and the virus is still very much a threat. We must continue to be cautious and follow the guidelines given.





