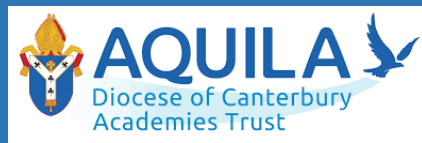

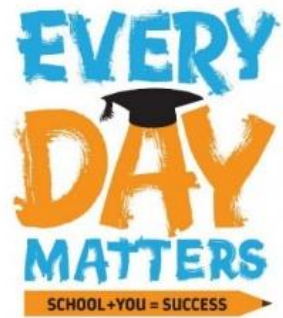

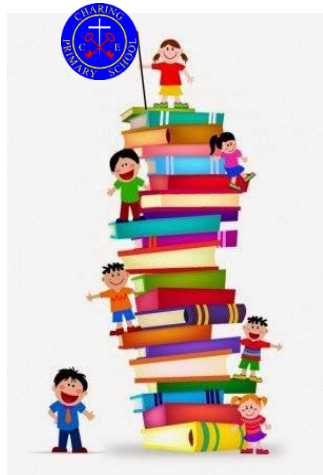
## Prayer

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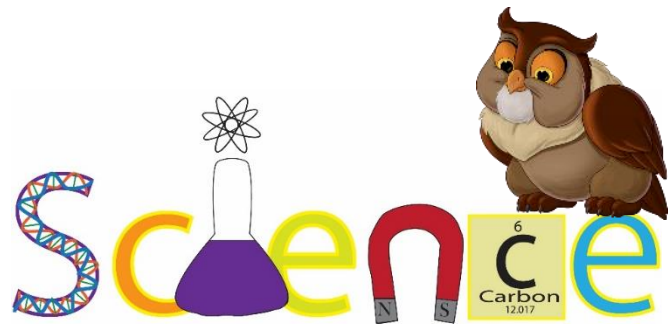


Foxes Class have impressed us with their fantastic first aid knowledge in their life skills class. There were some very professional looking slings!

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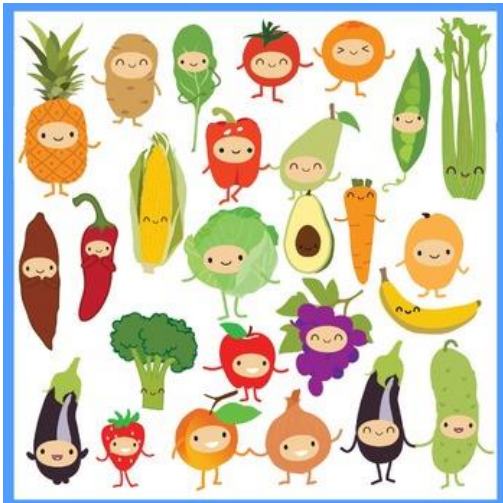
