

Charing CE Primary School Uniform Policy

At Charing CE School, we are proud of our school uniform and we would appreciate it if the whole school wore the appropriate clothing as it is part of the image of our school. All uniform and property should be named as we do not accept responsibility for loss or damage of personal items.

Summer uniform

- Plain blue polo shirt or shirt
- Black or grey socks
- Grey trousers, skirt (knee level) or long shorts
- Royal blue cardigan or jumper (available with Charing logo)
- Blue and white checked summer dress

Winter uniform

- Plain blue polo shirt or shirt
- Black or grey socks
- Grey trousers or skirt
- Royal blue cardigan or jumper (available with Charing logo)
- Blue or black tights

Footwear

- Black school shoes (not flashing)
- No heels
- Plain black boots are permitted in terms 2 -4
- Sandals are not allowed due to safety reasons
- Trainers are not acceptable for school shoes

Hair

- Long hair should be tied back
- No large bows or large hair accessories
- No extreme hair fashions are acceptable, including dyed or streaked hair
- No Mohicans or lines cut into the hair

PE kit

- Blue t-shirt (available with Charing school logo)
- Black or blue plain jogging trousers
- Blue or black shorts
- Black or blue plain jumper or hoodie with Charing school logo
- Trainers for external use and plimsolls for internal use

Jewellery

- A small, simple watch – smart watches are permitted to track fitness, but must not be connected to any device outside school and should not be able to receive communication at school.
- No necklaces or bracelets – unless part of a religion or medical need
- Earrings – 1 pair of small plain studs
- No make up
- No coloured nail vanishes

Following recommendation from the DfE and The Association for Physical Education (AfPE), children cannot wear jewellery during PE therefore if they have jewellery that they cannot remove themselves they will not be able to participate in the lesson due to health and safety. Teachers are not allowed to remove jewellery for them and covering earrings with sticky tape is not an option because of health and safety reasons.

Please ensure that your child has the correct school uniform. Thank you for your co-operation and ensuring that your child complies with the policy. We all would like a good learning environment for all our children so that they may take all advantage of the opportunity of progress at school without being distracted.

Hair

- Earrings - small plain studs (all jewellery to be removed for PE)
- No make up
- No coloured nail vanishes
