
## **Ducklings**

## **Rabbits**

We are so excited for this term with our focus being Animals. Each week we will focus on a different animal from our story and most of our learning will link to this animal. Our books this term are:















By the end of this term, the children will have been taught all of the set 1 RWI sounds and we will also begin reading short stories and words. In Maths, we are exploring 2D shapes and beginning to gain a deep understanding of the numbers within 10. Our PE topic this term is Gymnastics. Please ensure that all children have a pair of plimsoles at school that we can use in our PE lessons. In RE, we will begin by learning some Old Testament stories such as Noah's Ark and Joseph; our learning will then be heavily based on the Christian Nativity story. This learning will enable us to practice and perform our Nativity play to parents and carers later on in the term.

Towards the end of the term, our learning will link to Christmas and in the last week of term the children will have a range of different Christmas activities to get excited about from performing our own Nativity to having breakfast with Santa!
